Please note that in case of an emergency the time schedule may be shifted slightly which will be informed to all participants via email and social media - Instagram & Facebook.

### PRE - HAND PREPARATIONS

- **Please reach the venue 15 minutes before** the competition starts for your age group.
- Participant **who doesn't report** to the solving area at the allocated time can be **disqualified at the discretion of the super moderator**.
- Participants should be **accompanied by parents/guardians** during the competition (maximum 2 per participant).
- Participants have to **carry their ID card (Aadhar Card)** with themselves.
- Participants **must carry their own cubes** and spare cubes for the events they are participating in.
- The organizers **won't provide cubes** to participants on the day of the competition.



## **EVENT FLOW**

- Be seated in the **Audience area**.
- Be prepared with your **solved cube** for that event.
- When your event starts **go to the Registration Desk and check which Group you are in**. Depending on the participants in a competition, each event will have groups.
- Once your group is called, **place your cube in the box with your score sheet** (box and score sheet will be provided to you by JCA at the venue) and wait in the Participant waiting area.
- The **runner will call out your name** and will accompany you to a designated solving station with a judge.
- If **you are a first-timer**, ask the judge **to explain the Rules for solving before your first solve**.
- Once you have understood the process you can take up to a minute to calm down and only start when you are ready. **Say loudly and clearly “Yes Ready”** to the judge.
- Once the judge hears you say ready, they will proceed to lift the box and **start your inspection time**.
- You get 15 seconds of inspection time. During the inspection time, you are allowed to **lift the cube up but not make any move on it**.
- The judge will give you an 8-second warning, post that you should place the cube **down and place your fingers on the timer**.  
Wait till the light on the timer goes **from RED to GREEN**. After which the timer is ready and **you can start solving**.
- **Once you finish your solve, place the cube on the table and stop the timer with both hands. After the solve do not touch the cube or the timer.**
- The **judge will record your scores**. In case of any misalignment, the Super Moderator will take the decision.
- Once the time is noted down, please **check if the time is correct and sign besides it**.
- Once done, **wait till your cube again goes for scrambling**. This process will repeat as per the attempts given.

## **General Regulations**

- **Before entering the competition venue Phones / Devices on silent mode**. Please maintain decorum inside the competition venue.
- The audience should be **5 feet away from the solving area**.
- **Please don't use flash** while recording your child's solves.
- Participants **are not allowed to talk or use the phone** while solving the cube.
- If anyone from the **audience is disturbing the participant**, they are allowed to **report to the judge or the super moderator**.

### **PLEASE NOTE**

**Not following these rules will get you disqualified from the competition.**
